



2022 was a year of converging global challenges, including the lingering effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, rising costs of living, an increase in conflict, and soaring food poverty and hunger worldwide - all worsened by the impact of the climate crisis. 


YOUNG PEOPLE DRIVING CHANGE


