A GIFT IN YOUR WILL

By including Plan International Canada in your will, you can extend your compassion beyond your lifetime and transform the lives of children and girls for generations to come. Leaving a gift in your will is a simple and straightforward process, below we've got sample wording you can put in your will to make things even easier.

If you already have a will and prefer not to rewrite it, you can easily add a gift through a Codicil, a simple legal document that updates your existing will. Please ask your lawyer for more information.

Sample Will Wording

***Residual bequest:** You can choose to leave a percentage of your estate (for example, 10%, 25%, or 50%) after family, friends, other gifts, and expenses have been settled.

"I give to Plan International Canada Inc., currently located at 245 Eglinton Ave East Suite 300, Toronto, Ontario M4P 0B3, _____ (%) of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate to be used for its general charitable purposes."

Specific bequest: You can choose to give a gift of a fixed dollar amount or asset, such as stock and security.

"I give to Plan International Canada Inc., currently located at 245 Eglinton Ave East Suite 300, Toronto, Ontario M4P 0B3, the sum of \$_____ to be used in support of its general charitable purposes."
