Re: Canada's Commitment to the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria – Eighth Replenishment

I am writing as your constituent to seek your support to urge the Government of Canada to demonstrate global leadership and solidarity by making a strong and increased pledge to the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria as part of its Eighth Replenishment.

The Global Fund recently launched its investment case, calling on the world to contribute to save 24 million lives, reduce mortality from the three diseases by 75%, and strengthen health systems in over 120 countries. Canada has long been a proud and reliable partner of the Global Fund, helping to save over 65 million lives to date.

As part of the last funding cycle between 2021 and 2024 alone, Plan Canada's partnership with the Global Fund reached more than 25 million people across 15 projects and 12 countries, including an estimated 7.7 million girls and 5.1 million women.

This time, if the Global Fund can raise its proposed target for funding, it projects the number of deaths by these three diseases could drop from 2.5 million in 2023 to less than 1 million by 2029.

Despite incredible progress, the fight is not over. Every day, nearly 4,000 people die from AIDS, TB, and malaria—mostly in low- and middle-income countries, and disproportionately among women and young people. The Global Fund plays a vital role in protecting children, adolescent girls, and young women, who are among the most vulnerable to these diseases yet are often the drivers of change in their communities. It supports education, prevention, and health access that empowers a generation.

In the face of increasing global instability and climate threats, the Global Fund is a proven vehicle for health resilience and pandemic preparedness. That's why I'm calling on you to:

- Champion Canada's leadership role in global health
- Advocate for a **bold and increased Canadian pledge** to the Global Fund's Eighth Replenishment, building on Canada's past commitment;
- Support civil society engagement in global health efforts, including the voices of affected communities.

Investing in the Global Fund is one of the most effective and accountable ways to save lives, fight pandemics, and promote a healthier, more equitable world.

I look forward to your support and leadership on this issue.
